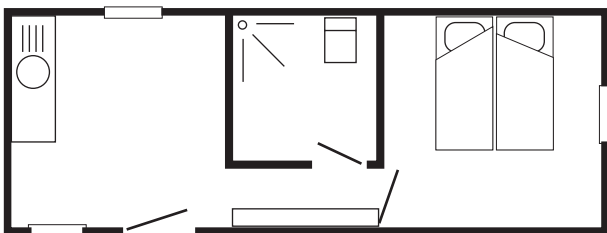

# Travel

The easiest way to reach us is by flying to Athens.

Flights are easily found on the internet. If you would like to arrive at Tinos within 1 day then your flight should arrive in Athens before 16.00 hours. And your flight for the return journey should be planned later in the day.

The local bus leaves from the airport every half an hour. You can find it on your right hand side after leaving the arrival hall, it is the last busstop, called RAFINA. It will bring you to the port where a ferry or seajet will leave between 17.30 and 18.00 o'clock for Andros-Tinos-Mykonos.

If you decide to stay on the mainland overnight we can arrange accommodation for you.

On arrival at Tinos port we will be there to welcome you.



## Anna's rooms

Anna's rooms, 500 mtr out of town towards Stavros bay.

You'll enter a warm decorated garden with space enough for everybody.

Shadow under the trees, deckchairs for relaxation and for children swings and a fake well filled with toys.

Each balcony has a terrific view over the harbour with the in- and outgoing traffic.

A bit further down, you'll find a small pebblebeach, but a 150 mtr. along the road lies the old port of Tinos, Stavros, a friendly bay to swim, for children as well, or to enjoy an ouzo with 'meze'.

On walking distance there are 2 more beaches, each with their own atmosphere.



## The island of Tinos

Tinos is part of the Cyclades group of islands.

We're one in the circle around Delos, Apollo's place of birth.

Other islands like Paros, Antiparos, Naxos, Mykomos and Syros are part of the view from our apartments. Daytrips to visit them are easily organised. We can inform you about that.

Tinos is the third largest island in the Cyclades.

From the original 60 villages there are about 40 left, each with its own characteristics. The atmosphere of the whole island is that of a green valley next to a stony landscape, rugged mountains full of olivetrees...

Twisting roads, leading us to outlying bays or busier beaches, but old paths inviting us to walk, for example to the top of the Exombourgo, a marble-quarry or a monastery.
